GPIB Treasurer Frequently Asked Questions

How to pay for GPIB fees

Venmo – PrestigeGPIB

Check – made out to GPIB and put in black box on front desk

Cash – be sure to get a receipt from Rachel at the front desk

Do I need to make separate deposits for everything?

No, the important thing is to know the total amount you need to have in your account and make sure it's there in full by the due date. For example, if you are ordering a leadership membership fees of \$1000 coming up, you're welcome to pay a lump sum of \$1300. Likewise, you can make small deposits and fundraise as you're able throughout the period you have it paid in full by the due date. If you have a surplus in your account and a fee comes up like states meet entrance fee, you do not need to make an additional deposit if you already have it.

If I fundraise, do I still have to pay the full fee amounts?

No that's the beauty of fundraising and the reason GPIB exists. The more you fundraise, the less you need to pay out of pocket! If you owe \$1000 and have \$500 in fundraisers, you only need to deposit \$500. We do have families who diligently fundraise and are able to cover all of their annual GPIB fees with their profits. It's possible and a blessing to have that!

How do I see my GPIB account?

I send out statements once a month, usually around the middle of the month. If you ever want to see your account statement, feel free to reach out anytime and I'll send you one.

**Treasurer makes no decisions on who to charge, when to charge, or how much to charge—all charges are dictated by meet decisions and gymnasium expenses.
